Spring time is starting with the Euonymus Paloma Blanca. It gives clear Mother-of-Pearl coloured new shoots which is starting in March until June. It gives the "WOW" effect in your garden from a distance. In the summer time the Paloma Blanca has fresh green leaves. The habitus is compact, dense and it is an evergreen. The last 4 winters the Paloma Blanca survived the winters, so it is really winter hardy. (survived winters of -18 Celcius)

Paloma Blanca for the growers

The Paloma Blanca is easy to grow. A rooted cutting can be potted in spring into a 1L, 1,5L or 2 liter pot. A liner (9CM) can be potted into 2L, 3L, 4L pot. Those are saleable the year after in spring. It has a compact habit so many plants can go on a trolley. It has an homogeneous growth habit so you can sell 99% of your plants. Whenever you don't sell them, you get pot them into a bigger pot, 5L, 7,5L or even bigger.



Paloma Blanca for the consumer

The Paloma Blanca is low maintenance. You can plant the variety into full sun and it doesn't burn, semi shade is also good. It loves all type of soil which makes it easy. In summertime you can prune if that is needed. You have to think out of the box with Paloma Blanca because it is multifunctional. Check it out below in several pictures.
